Coriesue Cook LCSW, ACSW, CEOLD, CMRM is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Certified End of Life Doula and Certified Master Level Medical Reiki practitioner. Ms. Cook specializes in medical trauma and vicarious medical trauma, utilizing a somatic therapy approach. Her therapy practice focuses on parents and other familial caregivers who are caring for a medically fragile child and going beyond typical parenting, by supporting their children through pain, illness, frequent medical procedures and other complex medical issues. Ms. Cook uses a holistic approach to therapy, incorporating both cognitive and somatic techniques, including trauma-informed meditations and other gentle methodology to work through vicarious medical trauma. Ms. Cook also provides pediatric end of life doula services for families preparing to part with their medically fragile and complex child.

Ms. Cook initially received her bachelor's degree in social work from Boise State University in 2003. She graduated with honors and was inducted into the Phi Alpha Honor Society. Ms. Cook completed a master's degree in clinical social work in 2005, graduating summa cum laude at Northwest Nazarene University. She was given the Outstanding Scholar Award and the Outstanding Thesis Award by the Northwest Nazarene University School of Social Work. Ms. Cook was added to the Academy of Certified Social Workers in 2012 through the National Association of Social Workers. In 2016, She added Reiki training in order to better assist clients emotionally and spiritually. Ms. Cook is currently a Reiki Master-Teacher, a Raven Keys Medical Reiki International Certified Medical Reiki Master, and a University of Vermont College of Medicine Certified End of Life Doula. She has received extensive training in multiple therapeutic modalities, including somatic work and other trauma-informed work. She has been providing service as a clinical therapist for over two decades.

Ms. Cook is a fourth-generation Idahoan. She currently lives in Boise, Idaho with her husband of 24 years, and their two children.
